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1.Introduction

1.1 General

This report details the results of two graveyard surveys undertaken within the village of Kilrush, Co. Wexford and formed part of a project entitled '*Two Churches – One Land*'. This project aims to highlight the shared cultural and natural heritage between both catholic and church of Ireland communities through the exploration of their graveyards.

The works were undertaken during the summer and autumn of 2025 and comprised the mapping and photographing of memorials within both graveyards. A previous survey was undertaken by the local community to transcribe the graves in 1990 and was subsequently published in a 'Memorials to the Dead' booklet (Hemmingway and Murphy, 1990). This additional survey work aimed to compliment the previous through the addition of mapping and photography. Also, numbers assigned to each memorial, during the previous survey, were cross referenced and utilised in this new work.

1.2 Site Location and Setting

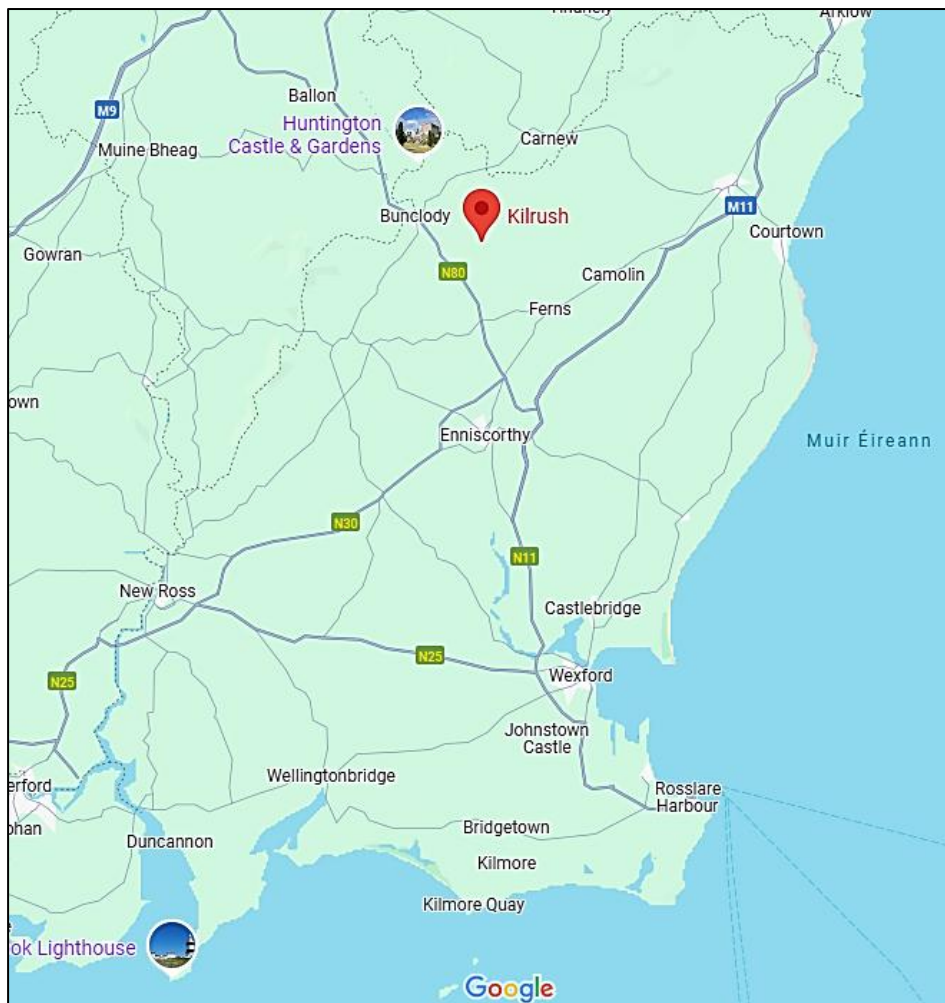


Figure 1: Location Map of Kilrush

Both graveyards are located within the village of Kilrush County Wexford (Figure 1). The 'Old catholic graveyard' is situated within the townland of Knockaree adjacent to the present St. Brigid's Catholic church and was once the site of the old catholic church. St. Brigid's Church of Ireland is situated a short distance west of the village, within the townland of Ballynaberney.

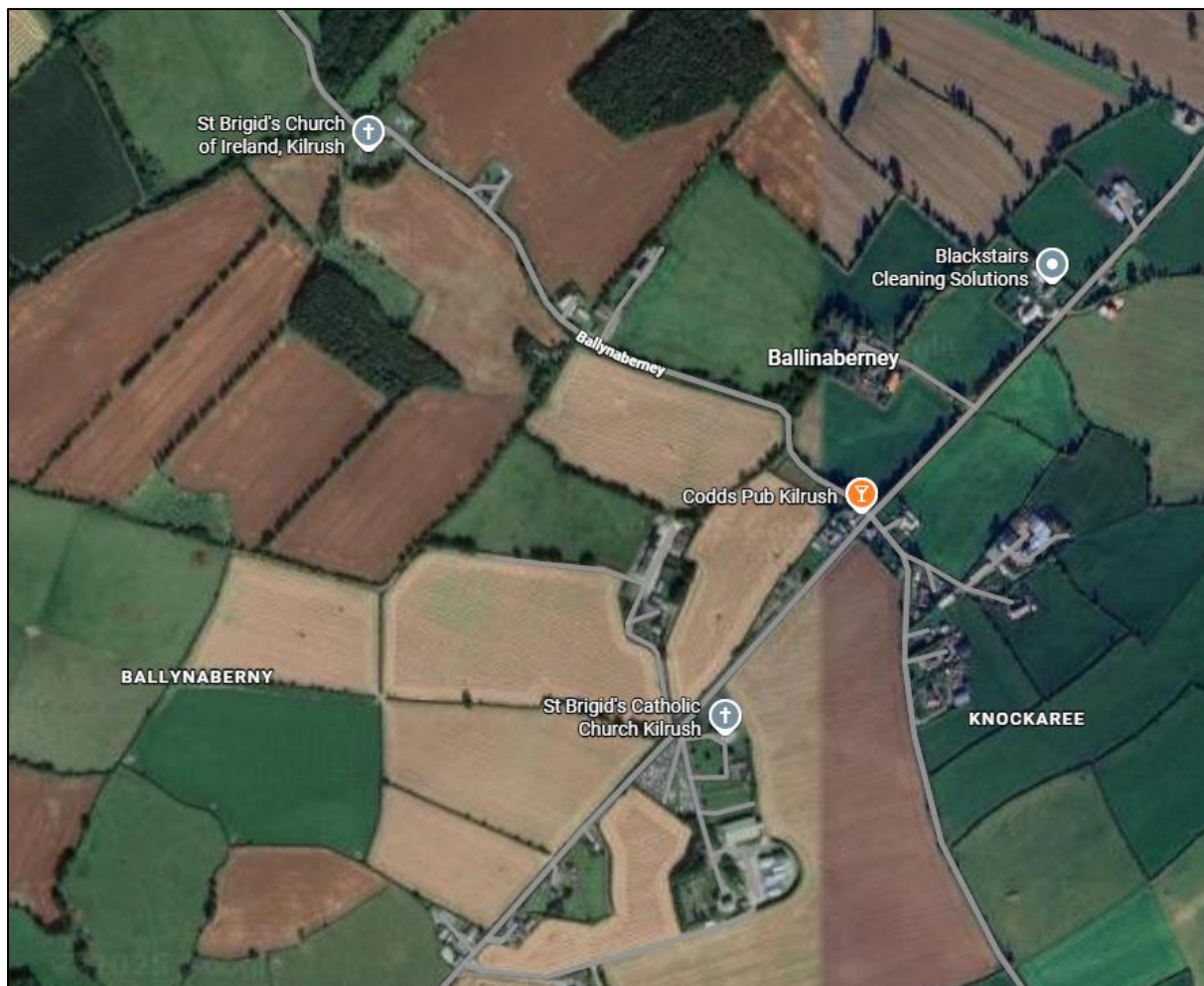


Figure 2: Map of Kilrush village with both churches visible

2. A Brief History

St. Brigid's church of Ireland is built upon the site of an early ecclesiastical foundation attributed to St. Columba Crossaire (Flood 1916, 34). It functioned as the location of the medieval parish church throughout the medieval period and was rededicated to St. Brigid in the 13th century (*ibid*). Following the reformation of the 16th century it became part of the newly established protestant church (Hemmingway and Murphy 1990, 9). A circular earthen bank encloses the graveyard and is characteristic of an ecclesiastic enclosure, a common feature of many early church sites. Additionally, a bullaun stone is recorded close by within a neighbouring field and is a further feature of early church foundations.

The site of the 'old Catholic graveyard', in the townland of Knockaree, was the location for the first post reformation church for the catholic community in Kilrush (Hemmingway and Murphy 1990, 10). This church was burned during the insurrection of 1798 and a subsequent new church was later constructed on the site. In the 1840s a new 'Barn type' church was built in its place. This was later demolished in around 1969 to be replaced by the current church located a short distance away.

3. How to Use This Resource

1. Both the 'Old Catholic Graveyard' and 'St Brigid's Church of Ireland' have been mapped with the location of each memorial recorded and can be viewed in Appendixes 1 and 4 at the end of this report.
2. Each memorial/grave has been given a number on their relevant maps. These correspond with numbers previously assigned during the survey undertaken in 1990. Details of each are available to view in appendixes 2 and 5 and have been taken directly from the 'Memorials To the Dead' booklet.
3. A photographic record was taken of each memorial and can be viewed in Appendixes 3 and 6 with their relevant number.
4. Details of newly recorded memorials and additional comments can be found in Appendix 7.
